There are a number of different types of records but the two main groups are official records and gifts and deposits. Official records comprise the records of Perth & Kinross Council and its predecessors, plus others such as customs records and records of the Justices of the Peace. Gifts and deposits are records that have been gifted or loaned indefinitely to the archive. The gifts and deposits collections are especially varied, comprising family and estate papers and records created by individuals, organisations, societies and businesses.

This summary is only an outline of the Archive's holdings. Visit our searchroom for complete descriptive lists of the collections. In addition appointments can be made up to a week in advance to consult the records on Tuesday and Thursday evenings between 5.00 pm and 8.00 pm.

There are finding aids, such as indexes and descriptive catalogues, to help you locate the records and information relevant to your enquiry. Archive staff are always ready to help and advise you.

Photocopies of documents can often be supplied. If you can't visit the Archive yourself, we can search our collections for answers to specific enquiries. Current charges for these services are available on our website or on request.

Burgh Records

B59 & PE Records of the Royal Burgh of Perth

The records of the Royal Burgh of Perth are in two separate series. The earlier records were transferred from the Scottish Record Office in Edinburgh to Perth when the Archive was established in 1978. A catalogue was compiled whilst the records were in Edinburgh and this catalogue is still used for the earlier burgh records which have the B59 prefix in their reference number. The later records remained and were catalogued in Perth. The later records have the prefix PE in their reference number. There is some overlapping content between the two record series.
